KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, _____, doing

Regal Customs Brokers .; its officers, employees, and/or specifically authorized agents, to act for and on its behalf as a true and lawful agent and attorney of the grantor for and in the name, place and stead of said grantor, for this date, in the United States (the territories) either in writing, electronically, or by other authorized means to:

Make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any customs entry, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet or any other documents required by law or regulation in connection with the importation, exportation, transportation, of any merchandise in or through the customs territories, shipped or consigned by or to said grantor;

Perform any act or condition, which may be required by law or regulation in connection with such merchandise deliverable to said grantor; to receive any merchandise;

Make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title; make entry or collect drawback; and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any statement or certificate required by law or regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such document is intended for filing with Customs Sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said grantor any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback, or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unlading or navigation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor, and any and all bonds which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable laws and regulations, consignee's and owner's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits or statements in connection with the entry of merchandise;

Sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with entering, clearing, lading, unlading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor; Authorize other Customs Brokers duly licensed within the territories to act as grantor's agent; to receive endorse and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in grantor's name drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; if the grantor is a nonresident of the United States, to accept service of process on behalf of the grantor; And generally to transact Customs business, including filing of claims or protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930, or pursuant to other laws of the territories, in which said grantor is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by an agent and attorney;

Giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents;

This power of attorney to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given to and received by grantee (if the donor of the power of attorney is a partnership, the said power shall in no case have any force or effect in the United States after the expiration of two years from the date of its execution);

Appointment as Forwarding Agent: Grantor authorizes the above grantee to act within the territories as lawful agent to sign or endorse export documents (i.e., commercial invoices, bills of lading, insurance certificates, drafts and any other document) necessary for the completion of an export on grantor's behalf as may be required under law and regulation in the territories and to appoint forwarding agents on grantor's behalf;

Customs duties paid directly to the broker will not relieve you of liability of payments owed U.S. Customs & Border Protection. You may pay U.S. Customs directly by send us a separate check payable to "U.S. Customs and border protection" which shall be delivered by the Customs Broker". Classification of merchandise on the 7501 is a courtesy, it is ultimately up to the Importer of record to check for any errors or omissions.

Shipments moving through a freight forwarder, Grantor waives the confidentiality requirements of 19 C.F.R 111.24 and recognizes that Regal Customs Brokers Inc., its subsidiaries, and related companies, may share and have access to information about the Grantor and its transactions with these entities and your designated freight forwarder(s), and waives the requirements of 19 C.F.R 111.36 of the Customs Regulations that the customs broker transmit a copy of its bill for service directly to the importer, and authorizes the customs broker to bill for services and transmit copies of the customs entry documents and related documents through Grantor's forwarder(s)
